Instructions – please read carefully

1. Zoom into your areas of interest within the red line (Strathard). The more you zoom in, the more accurate and precise you can be, allowing you to select even small sites that you value
2. Turn on the spray can by clicking the button in the top right hand corner to start spraying.
3. Turn off the spray can by clicking on the button to move to another area of the map or click 'Reset' in the top right hand corner to zoom back out
4. Spray any other areas you value for the scenery

Press 'clear' if you want to start again.
